I will not heckle, jeer or distract players and avoid profane and/or obnoxious language and behavior. I will treat my child and all other players, coaches, umpires and fans with respect and refrain from making derogatory remarks.

- 1) Registration/user fees/participation fees will be refunded in full if a player is cut from the team. Players who voluntarily drop an activity will forfeit the registration/user fee/participation fee. The registration/user fee/participation fee will be refunded on a prorated basis if the player is seriously injured or cannot complete the season due to illness and is unable to compete the remainder of the season.
- 2) The registration/user fee/participation fee will not be refunded if the player is suspended because of his/her grades, academic performance or drug/alcohol/tobacco violation.
- 3) Uniform deposit checks will be returned after the uniform/uniforms are returned to the head coach.
- 4) Fundraising deposit checks will be returned after the player turns in his season passes or tickets to the coaches/Renae Polensky/drop box, and turns in the money for any passes that are sold. The player will not be reimbursed for any passes that he purchased or sold.
- 5) Concession stand deposit checks will be returned if the player is cut from the team or the player is seriously injured and unable to compete the remainder of the season.

General Information

The Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. (DBC, Inc.) believes representing the City of Dickinson in baseball is a privilege which requires players to uphold high standards of citizenship, conduct and appearance at all times. The DBC, Inc. program is a voluntary program. Therefore, when a player chooses to join it, it means that he/she voluntarily accepts the terms, conditions and rules set forth by DBC, Inc. and it's coaches. All players, parents & coaches are required to read and sign a Code of Ethics. All players will conduct themselves as true representatives of Dickinson and the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. at all times. Any problems reported to DBC, Inc. will be dealt with promptly and appropriate action will be taken and reported to the player's parent/guardian. The following rules shall apply to all players in the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. program. They shall be in effect from the first scheduled practice of the baseball season until the player has returned home after the final game of the season.

Criminal Offenses

- 1) Use of any chemicals (tobacco/tobacco products, alcohol, steroids and nonprescription drugs other than over the counter) at any time is forbidden.
 - a. If a player is found of willfully possessing any of the above listed chemicals, the player will be benched six (6) weeks, effective immediately. If a player is found to have committed a second offense, the player will be suspended for the season.
 - b. If a player is found providing any of the above listed chemicals to others in any manner, the player will be suspended for the season.
 - c. If a player who is using a chemical tells his coach and asks for help, the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. will take this into consideration and will provide as much help as possible.
- 2) Criminal infractions such as shoplifting, walking out and not paying for meals, etc. will be handled immediately by reporting the same to the local law enforcement officials.
- 3) Damages to motel rooms will be paid for by the player or players responsible for the damages.

Any violation of the foregoing offenses will be reported to the parents, DBC, Inc. and local law enforcement, whenever appropriate.

Team Discipline

Discipline of the team will be the responsibility of the coaching staff. Players will be under the supervision and authority of the coaching staff on all trips. They will be expected to remain with the team until returning to Dickinson unless prior written arrangements are made. Coaches may have additional training rules/regulations that apply to players that are not listed in this statement. The coaches will explain these to the players at the start of the season. A Complaint/Grievance policy is in effect should legitimate disputes arise.

In case of hardship, please contact Renae Polensky at 483-6115 (home) or 290-2023 (cell). DBC, Inc. does not want to exclude any player from playing baseball. Please be prepared to write separate checks payable to DBC, Inc.

1) Players and parents will be asked to complete the following forms at registration:

- c. Player Code of Ethics
- d. Parent's Code of Ethics
- e. Consent for Treatment or Indemnification form

2) Registration fee - * See DBC, Inc. refund policy.

The registration fee includes a baseball hat. Contact Cory Hansen for additional information. No player will be allowed to play in a game until all fees and deposit checks are received by DBC, Inc. Babe Ruth players must participate in the League to play on the All Star team.

3) Fundraising deposit check

Babe Ruth League.....	\$ 100
Each player is required to sell \$100 of the Babe Ruth fundraiser.	
Babe Ruth All Star team.....	\$ 100
Each player is required to sell an additional \$100 of the Babe Ruth fundraiser. You may choose to pay the fundraising fee upfront and not do the fundraiser.	
Legion B & Legion players.....	\$ 200

This includes selling season passes. You may choose to pay the fundraising fee upfront and not sell the season passes. A returnable deposit check must be turned in to receive your season passes. Season passes should be sold & the money submitted to Renae Polensky.

*Players that played high school baseball may have already met their fundraising requirements be selling season passes this spring.

*Players may be asked to help work at other fundraisers such as Hit-a-thon, car wash, breakfast, dance, concessions, etc.

*All players will be required to participate in fundraising in order to participate in the program.

4) Concession stand/booth/gate*

Babe Ruth League.....	\$ 100
Babe Ruth All Star team.....	\$ 100
Legion B & Legion teams.....	\$ 200

Babe Ruth League parents are required to work a total of five games in concessions, at the gate/announcing/scoreboard/scorebook. Babe Ruth All Star parents are required to work five *additional* games in concessions, at the gate/announcing/scoreboard/scorebook. Legion B and Legion parents are required to work a minimum of 10 games in concessions, at the gate/announcing/scoreboard/scorebook. We will have sign up sheets at registrations, in The Dugout (concession stand) and in the gate area for to gate and working in the booth. Your deposit check will be returned at the end of the season if you work the required times. Parents are responsible for signing up to work. If you don't work *all required times*, your check will be cashed after the end of the home season. If you do not want to work, please let our concession stand managers know and they will cash your check and hire workers to help.

6) Registration Deadline

The registration deadline is to be determined. Any late registrations will be placed on a waiting list to see if there are available openings and enough coaches.

7) Age Requirements

Babe Ruth

13 year old division.....Players cannot turn 14 before April 30

14 year old division.....Players cannot turn 15 before April 30

Legion B.....Players cannot turn 18 before January 1

Legion.....Players cannot turn 20 before January 1

8) Meals and Lodging

One meal per day will be provided to each Babe Ruth, Legion B & Legion player on all overnight trips. Each player is responsible for providing all other meals. DBC, Inc. will pay for lodging on all overnight trips.

9) DBC, Inc. Refund Policy Approved by DBC, Inc. 2-13-02

- a.) Registration/user fees/participation fees will be refunded in full if a player is cut from the team. Players who voluntarily drop an activity will forfeit the registration/user fee/participation fee. The registration/user fee/participation fee will be refunded on a prorated basis if the player is seriously injured or cannot complete the season due to illness and is unable to compete the remainder of the season.
- b.) The registration/user fee/participation fee will not be refunded if the player is suspended because of his/her grades, academic performance or drug/alcohol/tobacco violation.
- c.) Uniform deposit checks will be returned after the uniform/uniforms are returned to your head coach.
- d.) Fundraising deposit checks will be returned after the player turns in his season passes or tickets to the Director of Baseball and turns in the money for any passes that are sold. The player will not be reimbursed for any passes that he purchased or sold.
- e.) Concession stand deposit checks will be returned if the player is cut from the team or the player is seriously injured and unable to compete the remainder of the season.

12) Season pass information

The cost of season passes is:

Combination DHS baseball, Legion & Babe Ruth games..... \$75 for a family pass
Combination DHS baseball, Legion & Babe Ruth games..... \$35 for a single pass
Students (grade 7 - college).....\$10 for a student pass

****Season passes do not include tournament games****

13) Regular Admission Cost

Legion & Legion B games
Adults.....\$5
Students (grades 7-12).....\$2
Kids grade 6 & below.....Free

Group Rate

If a group of 10 or more purchase tickets in advance, the cost is \$2 for adults, \$1 for students in grades 7-12 (1/2 price). Example: church groups, family reunions.

14) DBC, Inc. Players Admitted Free

All Dickinson baseball players will be admitted to the games at **no charge. Wear your DBC, Inc. baseball hat.**

15) Absences

It is important that players attend every practice and game. If there is a conflict, players or parents should notify the coach as soon as possible. If a player is ill and unable to attend a practice or a game, the coach should be notified. Absences should be discussed with the coach in advance, if possible. Each situation will be evaluated on its own merit. Church, school or family problems, drivers' education, will all be given consideration for missing practice or games-but they should be discussed with the coach in advance. If a player has missed practices or games, it is at the coaches' discretion when the player will be eligible for game play.

16) Player/Parent Agreement Form, Player Code of Ethics & Parent's Code of Ethics

Prior to the player being allowed to participate in the program players are required to read and sign the player/parent agreement form and the player's code of ethics. Parent/s or guardians are required to sign the player/parent agreement form and the parent's code of ethics.

17) Selection of Players

Selection of players for Legion and Legion B teams will be the responsibility of the coaching staff and will be based upon the following criteria: skill level and ability, work ethic and the ability of the players to meet the goals and objectives of the program. Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. does not guarantee participation or equal playing time to all players.

For Babe Ruth players, playing time in league games will be evenly divided among the player participants. For All Star games all players will be given a chance to play but not necessarily on an equal basis. During a regional tournament or State play off, there should be no specific expectations about playing time for any given participant.

18) Equipment Required

Players need to supply their own glove and baseball spikes (metal or rubber). Catchers gloves and bats will be supplied by DBC, Inc. Players may use their own bats but DBC, Inc. is not responsible for any personal player equipment. All players will be required to wear a protective cup.

19) Injuries

Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. will try to provide competent coaches, safe facilities and safe equipment. However, injuries can occur. If an injury occurs during practice or a game, notify your head coach or Corey Hansen at 406-208-0382.

20) Transportation

DBC, Inc. will transport players to out-of-town games. Parents may be requested to help with transportation at the Babe Ruth level.

21) Birth Certificates

A copy of your birth certificate is required if you are a Babe Ruth All Star player. A **certified copy** is required if you play Legion B or Legion. If you need to order a certified copy from ND, you can log onto to www.ndhealth.gov/vital. A list of other states is on our baseball website, www.dickinsonbaseball.com

22) Team Managers

Each team will have a team manager to help organize workers for games (gate, announcing, scoreboard, scorebook), help with collecting fundraising, etc. If you are interested in being a team manager, contact your team's coach.

23) Questions

24) DBC, Inc. Complaint/Grievance Policy

If there is a problem, please follow the following steps:

- a. try talking to the coach first to see if the problem can be resolved. This conversation should be at an appropriate time and place and should never occur within the first 24 hours after the alleged incident;
- b. if the problem can't be resolved, talk to the Director of Baseball;
- c. if the problem is still unresolved, you should write down your grievance and send it to the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. President, PO Box 1521, Dickinson, ND 58602.
- d. Your complaint must be signed to be considered.
- e. The DBC, Inc. Board will investigate the facts within a reasonable amount of time. The problem will be presented to the individual that the complaint was filed against. It will be presented individually, not in front of a group; and the Board will develop a plan of action to address each issue as it arises.

25) Parents

Parents or guardians have the responsibility to deal with problems along with the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. and support the program and coaches. Only with complete parental cooperation will a player be allowed to continue to be a part of the program. Please do not try to discredit the coach or criticize the program or act in an unsportsmanlike manner towards game officials at any time. Parents will be required to work at the concession stand, help with fundraising and work at games (announce/scoreboard/scorebook).

As a parent/guardian of a participating player, by my signature I hereby give my permission for him/her to participate in the Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc. program and release the City of Dickinson, Dickinson Baseball Club, Inc., Dickinson Park and Recreation District and all those associated with this program from any liability for injuries which may occur to the said player while participating in this program.
